Sept Meeting Minutes	Motion by Rickert to approve the Sept 11, 2025 meeting minutes as posted. Second by Symons. Unanimously approved.

State Trauma/ STAC	 STAC has not met since our last general meeting Next meeting is December 3 and fully virtual The 2026 Data Dictionary has been approved and posted https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/publications/p01117.pdf Michael reviewed the recently updated EMS and Falls report https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/publications/p03493-2024.pdf Discussion about the increasing number of cases from e-bikes and e-scooters. There is some concern about collecting good data and the need to educate EMS and hospital providers to properly document when one is involved. The ICD-10 coding is also not intuitive and may lead to cases being missed.

TXA bolus dose for EMS	Group discussed endorsing a 2 gram bolus dose for TXA when administered by EMS. The recent joint position statement from NAEMSP/ACEP/ACS-COT on TXA. https://journals.lww.com/jtrauma/fulltext/2025/09000/tranexamicacid in trauma_a_joint_position.6.aspx Group agreed to review and revise the NCRTAC position statement on TXA to include the 2 g dose as well as a pediatric dose. Michael will draft changes to the position statement and send it to MMC and AWH for TMD review and then put on the January agenda for approval
Process to reviewing requests for project and education funding	 Michael noted that the intervals in the process approved last meeting were too long and proposed a new timeline Motion by Horn to change the process to: Requests are due 14 days before a scheduled NCRTAC general meeting The RTAC Coordinator and Executive Council Chair will determine which committee will review the request or if the item should be placed on the general agenda If the committee or general membership do not come to a conclusion, the request will be sent to the Executive Council who will then meet within 30 days to make a determination. A form will be developed and information about the process will be placed on the website Second by Keffeler. Unanimously approved
