**Lenten Offering** – The theme for our midweek Lenten worship is water, baptism, and renewal. With that in mind, our midweek offering will go to ELCA Good Gifts for the gift of water – ceramic water filters, portions of an irrigation canal, a share of a water well, a sanitary latrine, or a combination thereof. During this rainy season for us, it is sometimes hard to remember that water is indeed a gift for those who don't have ready access. Help us give a generous "good gift!"

Clearing Up (Some) Confusion About the New Budget - Yes, we have moved many formerly designated funds INTO the general fund budget and added expense lines for them to be paid out of the general fund. This does NOT mean that you should no longer give to those ministries! We need to support them just as we always have – all that has changed is how they are accounted for. One of the greatest immediate needs is for Seminary Support for Melissa Anderson Trust; last year it was a dedicated fund (think cookie jar full of money) – now it is part of our general fund budget and we voted to fund it at \$500/month. Where will that money come from? It will come from each of us (over and above our regular tithe or offering).
