### **John the Baptist Prepares the Way**

3 It was now the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius, the Roman emperor. Pontius Pilate was governor over Judea; Herod Antipas was ruler<sup>[a]</sup> over Galilee; his brother Philip was ruler<sup>[b]</sup> over Iturea and Traconitis; Lysanias was ruler over Abilene. <sup>2</sup> Annas and Caiaphas were the high priests.
