The Prison Guard had a lot to say about the upcoming trial. When asked if she expected this to be a kangaroo court, her reply was, "No comment." Rumor has it that

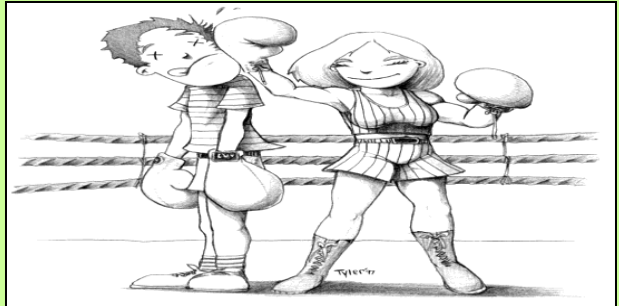
