CELL PHONE CALLS TO 911 TRINITY TRAIL 911 SIGNAGE

Using a cell phone to call 911 differs from a landline phone: emergency operators can't automatically identify you or your location. When calling 911, give your full name and cell phone number, the nature of your emergency, and your location.

SAFETY ADVISORY: On the Trinity Trail, be aware of the round 911 signposts. In an emergency, tell the emergency operator your location by referring to the closest signpost (e.g., WF 2705).

Many 911 calls from cell phones are accidental. Consider locking your keypad when not making a call.
