Noise in the Neighborhood

Last month we let you know about City laws pertaining to parking cars in our lawns. This month we are summarizing some of the City's rules regarding sound and noise in our neighborhood.

Noise generated by equipment such as stereos, speakers, etc. is regulated by **City Code Section § 9-2-5**. In summary, between 10:00 pm and 10:00 am you are not allowed to generate sounds that your neighbors can hear. Sound louder than 75 decibels is prohibited at all times. Call 3-1-1 if you are having a problem.

Laws pertaining to noise from animals (such as barking dogs) are found in **City Code Section § 3-2-2**. In summary, we are not allowed to keep animals that continually make noise that neighbors can hear. See www.austintexas.gov/faq/noise-issues-barking-dogs to learn how you can work to resolve an issue you may be having with a neighbor.
