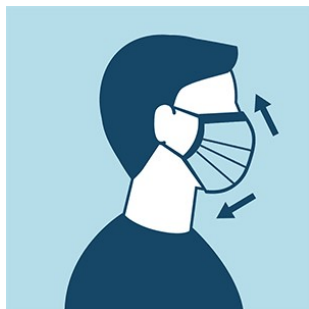
#### COVID REMINDER

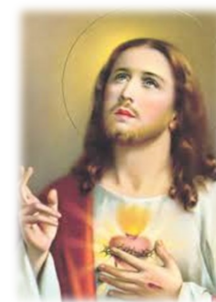
