

TRASH INSTRUCTIONS 2016

PICKUP TIMES

Trash Pickup begins at 6 AM on the following streets:

Perkiomen Avenue
Saint Lawrence Avenue
Prospect Street
Bingaman Street
N. Bingaman Street
Oley Turnpike Road
Beechwood Drive
Parkview Road

All other streets, collection begins at 7 AM
Recycling collections begins after all trash is collected.

TRASH AMOUNTS

3 – 32 gallon containers for trash

1 – Bulk item per week, must be able to be picked up by 2 people and must fit into the trash truck

Bulk item may be:

- One additional 32 gallon container of trash
- One piece of sectional sofa
- Mattress – any size
- Box spring – any size
- One piece of furniture

Any more than one bulk item at the curb will not be taken. Any item refused for collection must be removed within 24 hours.

The following are NOT ALLOWED AS A BULK ITEM:

- Tires and Tire Rims
- Items containing Refrigerants (Refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, dehumidifier, etc)
- Materials Classified as Hazardous Waste (oil based paint, water based paint in liquid form, solvents, motor oil, anti-freeze, items containing fuel, gas cylinders, etc.) Call the Borough office if you are not sure.
- Appliances
- Construction Debris
- Electronic Waste – computers, printers, monitors, hard drives, keyboards, mouse, etc.
- Any vegetation: grass, leaves, tree limbs, etc
- Televisions

WHEN PLACING TRASH & RECYCLING AT THE CURB –

1. PLEASE SEPARATE YOUR RECYCLING CONTAINERS FROM YOUR TRASH CONTAINERS.
2. MAKE SURE YOUR RECYCLING CONTAINERS ARE CLEARLY LABELED.
3. RECYCLING LABELS ARE AVAILABLE FOR FREE AT BOROUGH HALL. PLEASE CALL, WE WILL DELIVER.

RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

Single Stream – No need to separate

- Unlimited quantities within reason
- Free Recycling Stickers available at Borough Hall
- Please use a lidded recycling container, if your recycling is blown out of your container it is your responsibility to clean it up
- **BREAK DOWN CARDBOARD BOXES SO THEY ARE FLAT**
- Do not place recycling in plastic bags, it will be removed as trash
- **PIZZA BOXES ARE NOT RECYCLABLE**

ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED

- All numbered plastics except for Styrofoam (NO STYROFOAM)

- Newspaper
- Junk Mail
- Computer paper, office paper, notebook paper and gift wrap
- Magazines
- Paperback books (Goodwill accepts both paperback and hardback books at the donation center on St. Lawrence Avenue across from the shopping center)
- Brown paper bags
- Cardboard, chipboard (cereal and cake boxes) and carrier stock (soda and beer can carrying cases)
- Food grade glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum, bi-metal, steel and tin cans
- Clean aluminum trays and foil
