Title 3-1-2 (F) RV's are primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping or travel use, and shall not be used for living



quarters longer than two (2) weeks, except in a recreational vehicle park. The storage of a resident's recreational vehicle on his own property is permitted.



Please, **BE WATER WISE**

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM) 5-category system that measures the intensity of drought in a region as “D0” abnormally dry to “D4” exceptionally dry; Valley County currently registers as a level three or “D2” intensity. This information is updated weekly on Thursdays.

Declaration of Drought Emergency for Valley County

On June 21, 2021, the Idaho Department of Water Resources and Governor Little declared that Valley County is experiencing “moderate to severe drought” conditions. For the full text of declarations access idwr.idaho.gov
