## **SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION, 2014**

Sponsored by Dedicated to Learning

Dedicated to Learning, a nonprofit corporation, has been authorized by the Walnut Valley Unified School District to provide a Summer School program at Chaparral Middle School. Dedicated to Learning, in an effort to provide the best possible learning environment for your children, will employ Walnut Valley Unified administrators, teachers and staff for its summer session of enrichment classes.

The courses offered through the Dedicated to Learning will be financed through tuition. Any students currently attending a school in the Walnut Valley Unified School District, or who reside in the Walnut District attendance area and will be **in grades 6, 7, or 8 in August of 2014** may enroll in courses appropriate for them, as class size permits.

There will be two (2) Sessions offered to students at Chaparral Middle School this summer:

**First Session:** Monday, June 9 – Thursday, July 10, 2014. Classes will meet Monday through Thursday. There are no Summer School classes on Fridays.

• Classes run from 7:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. each day.

**Second Session**: Monday, July 14 – Thursday, July 31, 2014. Classes will meet Monday through Thursday. There are no Summer School classes on Fridays.

• Classes run from 7:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. each day.

**CLASS SIZE:** Each course offered through this program will have a class size of approximately 25-35 students, excluding PE.

Enrollment begins March 14, 2014 until classes fill. Students are to choose two (2) classes minimum per period, per session.

If a student does not receive their first (1<sup>st</sup>) choice because their choice is full or no longer offered (dropped due to lack of enrollment), the student will be placed in their second (2<sup>nd</sup>) choice. **Students will not be placed in the same class for both periods.** 

**TUITION:** The cost for the first (1<sup>st</sup>) session, five (5) week instructional program is \$425, which includes two (2) classes. The cost for the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) session, three (3) week instructional program is \$260, which includes two (2) classes.

You may sign up for both sessions. The cost for a combo of both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> session is discounted at \$650.00 which would include four (4) classes.

(When registering for both sessions, students will be attending the two (2) classes they choose for the first five (5) weeks and will continue on to the second session into the next two (DIFFERENT) classes they choose for the remaining three (3) weeks.)
