

Moses and Aaron Wilcox deed to the Township of Twinsburg

To all people to whom were present shall come Greeting. Know ye that we Moses & Aaron Wilcox both of Killingworth County of Middlesex state of Con. for the consideration of fifty dollars received to our full satisfaction of the Township of Twinsburg Portage County State of Ohio do give grant – bargain as sale and confirm the Trustees & their successors in office a certain piece of land situated in Twinsburg Portage County Ohio containing six acres Bounded to wit. Beginning at the center of the east and west road at the center of the afd[aforesaid] Township there to run north thirty two rods – thence west thirty rods – thence south thirty two rods – thence east to the place of beginning to contain six acres of land. To have and to hold the above granted & bargained promise with the appurtenances. Thereof to their own proper use and behalf. And also we the said Moses and Aaron do for ourselves & our heirs, executors & administrators covenant with the said Township Trustees afd that at and until the unsealing of these presents we are seized of the promises as a good indefeasible estate. In fee simple I have a good right to bargain & sell the same in manner & form as above written.

And furthermore we the said Moses and Aaron Wilcox Huldah Wilcox and Mable Wilcox do by these present bind ourselves and our heirs forever to warrants & defined the above granted & bargained premises to the aforesaid Township Trustees & their successors in office against all claims and demands whatsoever. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this twentieth day of February One Thousand Eight hundred and twenty-two.
