Michigan showed fight during and after the game in their shocking upset of No. 2 Ohio State 13-10. The near 3-TD underdog Wolverines were +850 on the money-line and it was the largest upset in the rivalry going back more than 50 years. It was also Michigan's 4th straight win in the series after going 1-14 the previous 15.

Misleading Finals

Toledo (-9) lost outright to Akron 21-14 in OT. However, Toledo had 30-18 first down and 465-328 yard edges. Toledo missed three FG's and fumbled at the Akron 4-yard line.

Nebraska (+3) lost at Iowa 13-10. However, Nebraska had dominant 20-5 first down and 334-164 yard edges. The Huskers were -2 in TO's, missed a FG, muffed a punt that set up an Iowa FG and a late fumble set up Iowa for 53-yard FG on the final play of the game.

Utah (+10) upset UCF 28-14. However, UCF had 22-11 first down and 379-196 yard edges. UCF was -3 in TO's. They were stopped on downs at the Utah 37 and 39-yard lines. Utah also got a 60-yard "Pick 6" and a 13-yard "Pick 6".

UTEP (+3) upset New Mexico State 42-35. However, New Mexico State had dominant 33-14 first down and 543-298 yard edges. New Mexico State was -2 in TO's and UTEP scooped three non-offensive TD's! Finally, New Mexico State missed three field goals. Can you say misleading!?!?

Georgia Southern (-2.5) beat Appalachian State 29-20. However, Appalachian state had a 465-357 yard edge. App State was stopped on downs at the Georgia Southern 1-yard line, intercepted at the GS 16 and missed a FG.

Marshall (+4) upset James Madison 35-33 in 2OT. However, James Madison led 17-0, had a 382-261 yard edge but a Marshall "Pick 6" changed momentum in the game.

Illinois (-9) beat Northwestern 38-28. However, Northwestern had a 442-382 yard edge but the Wildcats were -2 in TO's.

Missouri (-3) beat Arkansas 28-21. However, Arkansas had a 377-361 yard edge. The Razorbacks were -2 in TO's, were stopped on downs at the Missouri 31 and both of their fumbles set up Missouri in Arkansas territory for short TD drives.

Utah State (+5) led Colorado State 30-13 in the 4th quarter but lost 42-37.

LSU scored the game's final 20 points to beat Oklahoma 37-17.

North Texas and Temple combined for ZERO points in the second half (North Texas won 24-17).

Bad Beats

Wake Forest (+3.5) lost to Duke 23-17. Wake led 17-3 at one point. Duke got a 39-yard "Hail Mary" TD pass on the final play to win. It was the only time in the entire game that Duke was covering.

The total in the Maryland/Penn State game was 50.5. Instead of taking a knee, Penn State head coach James Franklin elected to throw a 15-yard TD pass on 4th & 12 on the final play of the game to give Penn State a 44-7 win and put the game OVER by a 0.5-point.

Notre Dame (-7) beat USC 49-35. However, USC had 557-436 yard edge. Notre Dame got a 99-yard interception return TD and a 100-yard interception return TD in the fourth quarter when it looked like USC would get a cover. The Irish became the first team in the last 25 years of CFB to have two "Pick 6's" in a game of that length.

Week 15 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

This year's record is 19-27 so far. Of the games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **No games qualify this week.**

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Betting CFB Openers

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Friday, December 6th

AAC Championship - Michie Stadium - West Point, NY

Tulane 26 ARMY 20. We've upgraded these two teams significantly since the start of the season. Tulane has the better ypp margin (+1.5 vs +1.1) and has played the much tougher schedule (No. 78 vs No. 125). Tulane head coach Jon Sumrall has faced the option three times the last three years (2022 Army, 2023 Army, 2024 Navy) and his teams have given up a total of 9 points including ZERO the last two. We do worry that he might be interviewing for jobs as Tulane had their worst performance of the season last week. Still the Green Wave are 9-3 ATS (+10.5 ppg) on the season. Army started the season 6-0 ATS but are just 1-4 ATS since and their only cover was fortunate vs North Texas. These are two of the slowest tempo teams in CFB (Tulane No. 130 vs Army No. 134) so no surprise UNDER money is coming in. Lean Tulane.

CUSA Championship - AmFirst Stadium - Jacksonville, AL

JACKSONVILLE STATE 30 Western Kentucky 26. These two just met last week. WKU won 19-17 as 1-point underdogs kicking a 50-yard FG with :03 left to get the win. WKU did have a 426-328 yard edge in the game but Jacksonville State controlled the line of scrimmage with a 229-105 rush edge. This is a one factor handicap. Jacksonville State QB Tyler Huff hurt his ankle in last week's game. He will be a game-time decision. If he can go and be close to 100%, this number seems light. Jacksonville State will be able to fully take advantage of a WKU defense that has been gashed on the ground in recent weeks. If Huff can't play, Logan Smothers is an experienced and talented backup but definitely a downgrade. Jacksonville State has been better in ypp (+0.8 vs +0.1). We lean UNDER.

Mountain West Championship - Albertsons Stadium - Boise, ID

BOISE STATE 30 UNLV 26. Boise State won 29-24 at UNLV as 4-point road favorites back on October 25th. So now Boise is at home and still laying only 4 points? Value on Boise...right? Wrong! Since that game Boise has not looked the part as the Broncos would be on a 0-4 ATS run if not for a miracle cover vs San Jose State. Meanwhile, UNLV has out-rushed their last 4 opponents 275-74 on average. Boise has done a nice job of defending UNLV WR Ricky White the last two matchups (this year and last year's Mountain West Championship) and also got after UNLV QB Williams (6 sacks). On the other side, UNLV's defense held Boise RB Ashton Jeanty to a season-low 3.9 yards per carry. UNLV has the slightly better ypp (+1.4 vs +1.3) and has played the slightly tougher schedule. Early money came in on UNLV but we're passing at the current numbers.

Saturday, December 7th

Big 12 Championship - AT&T Stadium - Arlington, TX

† **Arizona State 25 Iowa State 24.** This is the first time Iowa State has been an underdog since at Iowa all the way back in Week 2. Iowa State has won 10 games for the first time in school history but hasn't been overly dominant (+0.6 in ypp). We like their weapons at WR in Jayden Higgins and Jaylin Noel who each have more than 1,000 yards receiving. Meanwhile, we've upgraded Arizona State the 3rd most of any team in the country. The Sun Devils are 10-2 ATS covering by 10.0 ppg. Their star is RB Cam Skattebo who has 1,866 rushing and receiving yards and 19 TD's. However, they will be without their 2nd best player on offense in WR Jordyn Tyson (1,101 yards and 10 TD's) who got hurt last week. Normally, Iowa State plays a 3-3-5 defense but we would like to see them put more guys in the box to stop Skattebo and force QB Sam Leavitt to beat them with an underwhelming ASU WR corps without Tyson. We bet Arizona State on the open as an underdog but would lean Iowa State at current.

MAC Championship - Ford Field - Detroit, MI

† **Miami, OH 23 Ohio 21.** Remarkably, Ohio hasn't won the MAC since 1968 while Miami is the defending MAC Champs. The Bobcats are 0-5 in MAC Championship games. Miami, OH was a 3.5-point home favorite on October 19th and beat Ohio 30-20 (total 43.5). Miami led 30-6 before Ohio scored a couple of TD's in the final half of the 4th quarter. Ohio threw it 43 times by far their most in a game this season as they were playing catch-up. We've upgraded the Bobcats the 5th most of any team this season and the Bobcats have covered in 5 straight games. They are playing their best ball of the season but so is Miami, OH. The RedHawks have the better ypp margin (+1.6 vs +1.2) and have played the tougher schedule. These are two slow tempo teams (Ohio No. 120 vs Miami, OH No. 124). We haven't bet the game yet. A sharp betting group did bet Ohio +3 on Wednesday morning.

SEC Championship - Mercedes-Benz Stadium - Atlanta, GA

† **Texas 24 Georgia 23.** Georgia is 0-7 ATS laying more than 2 TD's this year but this is only the 2nd time they've been an underdog this season. Obviously the first was at Texas where they won 30-15 as 4-point underdogs. Georgia got after the Texas offense with 7 sacks. To put in perspective, Texas only allowed 15 sacks their other 11 games combined. The Longhorns only managed 29 rushing yards and 1.1 yards per carry, it was the only game all season they were held under 100 and under 3.1 ypc. Playing from behind, they had 49 pass attempts but only averaged 4.7 yards per attempt. The Horns have really leaned on their run game the last two weeks vs two good DL's in Kentucky and Texas A&M. RB Wisner had 158 and 186 rushing yards the last two weeks and has emerged as their go-to offensive weapon. On the injury front, Texas LT Kelvin Banks got hurt in last week's game. We will see if he plays and if he is close to 100%. Statistically, this is the worst defense for Georgia since Kirby's first season in 2016. They just gave up 563 yards to Georgia Tech and were on the field for 8 OT's. They have been up and down all season and do play to the level of competition. You should be awarding Georgia 1-point for homefield since they will have the crowd edge and play in this building routinely. We lean UNDER and Georgia.

Sun Belt Championship - Cajun Field - Lafayette, LA

UL-LAFAYETTE 31 Marshall 25. UL-Lafayette has a huge ypp edge (+1.6 vs +0.4) which is the biggest disparity in the conference championship games this week. We think Marshall is OVERRATED as they were out-gained in conference play this season. The Thundering Herd were a fortunate team (4-1 in close games) which included a come-from-behind 2OT win at James Madison last week. We're also hearing head coach Charles Huff has one foot out the door (rumors are he's taking the Southern Miss job). On the other side, the market downgraded ULL too much for QB Ben Wooldridge being out last couple of games. Chandler Fields is one of the most experienced backups in CFB with 426 career pass attempts. The last two games he is completing 75% averaging 10.0 yards per attempt with a 5-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio and is No. 11 in Weighted EPA/Dropback. We like ULL.

ACC Championship - Bank of America Stadium - Charlotte, NC

† **Clemson 28 Smu 27.** You should be awarding Clemson 1-point for having the crowd edge while also playing in this game routinely. Even at 11-1, we don't think SMU is automatically in the playoffs. They need to win here or we think they'll get left out. The move to QB Kevin Jennings in the middle of the season was the right one. (67%, 9.3 ypa No. 6 nationally). RB Brashard Smith has 1,154 yards and 14 TD's. However, we are concerned about their OL. It was a weakness early in the season and they haven't played a Top 40 team since Louisville 7 games ago. This is also the type of game where they will really miss TE RJ Maryland who was their most talented pass catcher. Statistically, this is the worst Clemson defense since 2013. Their weakness has been on the ground this year...can SMU exploit it? We do expect Clemson DE TJ Parker (10 sacks) to have a big game. We bet SMU +3 on a bad opening number but actually like Clemson at current.

Big Ten Championship - Lucas Oil Stadium - Indianapolis, IN

† **Oregon 28 Penn State 24.** Just to show how down CFB is this year, we have 12-0 Oregon No. 1 in our power ratings despite the fact, we've downgraded the Ducks one point since the start of the season. That's how disappointing teams like Ohio State and Georgia have been. We really liked what we saw from the Oregon offense vs Washington last week. It was the healthiest they've been in several weeks (got back WR Tez Johnson). They have a variety of weapons including QB Gabriel (73.5% 24-to-6 TD-to-INT ratio, No. 3 in QBR) and RB Jordan James 1,166 yards. The OL has given up a total of 5 sacks the last 10 games after giving up 7 the first two games. That includes ZERO sacks allowed vs Ohio State and Michigan's elite fronts. Generally speaking we think the Penn State defense is OVERRATED. USC put up more than 400 yards and Ohio State was able to run on them with a banged up OL and bled the clock out. Those were the only Top 50 offenses Penn State has faced this season. This is the best offense they have faced. On the other side, Penn State will have to get their ground game going with RB Singleton. TE Warren is obviously another matchup nightmare. We lean Oregon and the OVER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 5th

Green Bay 27 DETROIT 26. Both teams are coming off wins at home on Thanksgiving. Detroit's 11-1 record is their best start to a season in franchise history (back to 1934). The Lions are 9-3 ATS and have covered 70% of their games since Dan Campbell took over. That's the good news. The bad news is that they are arguably the most banged up team in the NFL particularly on defense. Now they get a Green Bay team that is No. 5 in ypp margin and No. 5 in DVOA. We think there's a good chance for the outright upset but will be happy to take "the hook" on a key number.

Sunday, December 8th

MINNESOTA 25 Atlanta 19. The two teams had misleading finals last week. Atlanta had a 350-187 yard edge vs the Chargers but found a way to lose 17-13. QB Kirk Cousins was the culprit with 4 interceptions including a "Pick 6". Obviously, one of the story lines will be his return here where he was the QB from 2018-2023. Meanwhile, Minnesota got outgained 406-273 yet won 23-22 over Arizona. Minnesota is the better team in the stats (+0.5 vs +0.2 in ypp margin) and have played the tougher schedule (No. 13 vs No. 21). Totals players note the two teams are a combined 16-8 to the UNDER this season.

New Orleans 23 N.Y. GIANTS 19. Not sure how much interest we have in this game. The Giants have now failed to cover the spread in 7 straight games after falling to the Cowboys on Thanksgiving. They rank No. 30 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, the Saints got a couple game bump with the interim coach but then after a bye lost at home to the Rams last week. Not sure, we can trust a 4-8 team laying this kind of number on the road but the Giants are really bad and have locker-room issues.

TENNESSEE 21 Jacksonville 17. Jacksonville QB Trevor Lawrence is still in concussion protocol and will not practice Wednesday. Obviously, he took a brutal hit from Houston safety Azeem Al-Shaair who has been suspended multiple games. It's been a season to forget for Jacksonville at 2-10 SU (but still 6-5-1 ATS). They are No. 26 in ypp margin and DVOA. They just lost their RB coach to Kennesaw State and we expect them to get rid of Doug Pederson after the season (at least you'd think). Tennessee has also been a dumpster fire at 3-9 SU and a league-worst 2-10 ATS. They just got destroyed by Washington last week. The market gets betting them because their stats are decent at (+0.0 in ypp margin). If Lawrence is out, we lean with Tennessee.

TAMPA BAY 28 Las Vegas 21. Las Vegas has extra time to think about the wasted opportunity at Kansas City last Friday. The Raiders missed 3 FG's and fumbled late in FG range and lost by 2 as 13.5-point underdogs. The Raiders had a dominating 6.9 to 4.9 ypp edge on the Chiefs. Meanwhile, Tampa Bay escaped the upset at Carolina in OT. Obviously, TB is better in ypp and DVOA and spirits have to be better in the locker-room with Las Vegas likely making a coaching change. Totals players note the two teams are a combined 16-8 to the OVER and that's where our recommendation is.

PITTSBURGH 27 Cleveland 19. These two just met on November 21st with Cleveland pulling the 24-19 upset as 3.5-point home underdogs in a game notably played in heavy snow in the second half. We like Pittsburgh to get revenge. The Browns are traveling off a short week after a wild 41-32 loss at Denver on MNF. Cleveland QB Winston threw for a franchise-record 497 yards and 4 TD's but also threw a pair of "Pick 6's" and another interception near the goal line. On the other side, Mike Tomlin has done it again. The Steelers clinched another winning season by upsetting Cincinnati on Sunday. Pittsburgh has the much better ypp. We like them here and also lean OVER.

PHILADELPHIA 28 Carolina 17. Philadelphia is red-hot with 8 straight wins (6-2 ATS) and last week upset Baltimore 24-19 as 3-point road underdogs. Baltimore did have a 372-252 yard edge as Ravens kicker Justin Tucker missed a PAT and two FG's. Meanwhile, Carolina has shown a ton of fight lately with 4 straight covers. They're coming off back-to-back close losses in the final seconds. Philly is much better in ypp margin (No. 2 vs No. 26). However, this seems like clear flat spot for the Eagles with Pittsburgh on deck.

MIAMI 27 N.Y. Jets 21. Every single week we see "the pros" betting on the N.Y. Jets. They are now on a 1-8 ATS run despite some solid stats (+0.0 in ypp margin). Somehow they are 3-9 SU despite being favored in 9 of their 12 games. Last week was another upset loss to the Seahawks. The Jets actually led 21-7 before allowing the game's final 19 points. Meanwhile, Miami has been improved with Tua at QB. After 4 straight covers, the Dolphins lost their 12th consecutive game in temperatures below 40 degrees last Thursday in Green Bay. We lean OVER here.

ARIZONA 24 Seattle 21. These two just played on November 24th with Seattle winning 16-6 as 1-point home underdogs. Seattle has won and covered 3 straight since their bye. They rallied from 14 down last week in New York as Leonard Williams got a 92-yard "Pick 6", the longest by a DL in NFL history. They're taking on an Arizona team that had a misleading 1-point loss to Minnesota last week. The Cardinals had a 406-273 yard edge. Arizona is much better in ypp margin (+0.5 vs +0.0) and DVOA (No. 6 vs No. 16). and have played the tougher schedule (No.1 vs No. 17). We lean with them here.

Buffalo 28 L.A. RAMS 24. Buffalo is 10-2 SU for the first time since 1991. They are the first team to clinch a division with 5 games remaining since Indianapolis did it in 2009. The Bills have covered 6 of their last 7 games. Statistically, they haven't been as dominant and obviously will benefit from playing 3 weak AFC East opponents down the stretch. This is a tough 2-game road trip for them with Detroit on deck as they try to keep pace with the fraudulent 11-1 Chiefs. Meanwhile, the Rams can't seem to put it all together. They are 6-6 but -0.3 in ypp margin. They were exposed at home a few weeks ago by Philadelphia. Will they get exposed again? Look for a ton of Bills fans in the stands. We lean OVER.

SAN FRANCISCO 23 Chicago 20. Both teams come in reeling. The Bears have lost 5 straight and deservedly fired Eberflus after another close game loss to the Lions on Thanksgiving. Eberflus' 5-17 record in games decided by 7 points or less was dead-last all-time in the NFL (minimum 20 games). Thomas Brown will be the interim coach and we will see if the Bears get the interim bump. Meanwhile, San Francisco is 4-8 ATS and RB McCaffrey looks like his season is over (maybe his career at this point). The 49ers are still No. 2 in ypp margin but are really banged up and it's looking more and more like it will be a non-playoff season. More questions than answers.

KANSAS CITY 23 L.A. Chargers 20. Obviously, Kansas City is not as good as their 11-1 record. The Chiefs are -0.1 in ypp margin which indicates they are average. They are 9-0 in games decided by 7 points or less and benefitted from 3 missed Raiders' field goals last week and an ill-timed fumble. As a near 2-TD favorite, Kansas City had a -2.0 yards per play deficit. Yikes! The Chargers also had a misleading win last week as they were outgained 350-187 but somehow beat the Falcons. They intercepted Kirk Cousins 4 times and got a "Pick 6" in the 17-13 win. The Chargers are +0.1 in ypp margin. We lean with them here as Kansas City's OT's are really struggling. The Chiefs have failed to cover the spread in 5 straight while the Chargers are 8-3-1.

Monday, December 9th

Cincinnati 26 DALLAS 21. Dallas has won two straight games but still rank No. 29 in ypp margin. Cincinnati has also been one of the most disappointing teams in the NFL. Despite being favored in 8 of their 12 games, the Bengals are 4-8 SU. They suffered another upset loss last week this time to the Steelers as they allowed 44 points, more than 500 yards and 7.9 yards per play. Cincinnati is still +0.1 in ypp margin but we can't trust them laying this number on the road. Pass.
