We also want to especially thank Deb Pennington and all of her many TBLA BU committee volunteers that planned, coordinated and worked to deliver this event to the Lake Community. I am sure I speak for most of the volunteers when I say that we are glad that we do not have another BU Planning meeting for at least 4 months. Please save the date however for next year's BU Banquet which will be later than normal and take place on Friday, May 10, 2019, the Friday before Mother's Day. Due to scheduling conflicts for Cypress Bend Park and Marina, we had to move our 2019 date, and we hope that by making everyone aware as early as possible, that this date will work for our repeat participants.

The TBLA Board of Directors — We announced last month that The Board met on April 17th and approved a grant request for a TBLA project to purchase 50,000 Florida bass fingerlings that will be released in June. The TBLA Fingerling Release is currently scheduled for Wednesday June 6th, at 8:30a.m.until noon, at Cypress Bend Park. Details or changes in this schedule will be communicated on our website and both the Toledo Bend Lake Association and Toledo Bend Lunker Bass Program Facebook pages. *Participants must be a current member of TBLA*. For those that would like to participate who are not current members, we will be offering memberships at the fingerling release on the 6th at Cypress Bend. Fingerlings may be picked up by car or boat. There will be a 2- bag limit per vehicle or boat used to transport the fingerlings. We hope that all of you will help us distribute these fingerlings throughout the lake to ensure as much survival of these fish as possible.

<u>Toledo Bend Lunker Bass Program</u> – We currently have 39 Lunkers in the 2017-2018 Lunker Bass Program. We have a month left in this year's cycle so we will likely end up with 40-50 for the final number in this year's program.

<u>Safety Awareness for the Lake</u> – The Lake is now falling after remaining full or above for the last 3 or 4 months. The stumps will be visible again soon or lurking just under the surface for your prop or lower unit. Running only on the marked boat roads will be the only safe way to travel as the Lake begins its normal summer drawdown in the next 60 days.
