Monday, April 7 in the Weston
County Courthouse for the trial
of The State of Wyoming vs.
Megan Martin.

The formal charge being; Aggravated Child Abuse, on or about November 16, 2021 in Weston County. The defendant, Megan Martin was a person responsible for the welfare of 'P.W.', a child under the age of 18 years old, intentionally inflicted serious bodily injury which was not the result of corporal punishment upon 'P.W.'

Following a deliberation of less than an hour, the jury's official verdict was announced - not guilty. As stated in the court documentation;

We the Jury, duly empaneled and sworn to try the entitled cause, do find that as to the crime of Aggravated Child Abuse, the Defendant, Megan C. Martin is: Not Guilty.
