APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY LAUGHTER

Our successful Season concludes with the Neil Simon classic comedy, **Laughter on the 23rd Floor**, opening next month. Playwright Neil Simon got his first big break in the early '50s as a staff writer on Sid Caesar's fabled television series Your Show of Shows, and this comedy takes a fictionalized look at the backstage chaos that went into producing one of the landmarks of television's golden age.

Max Prince is the star of The Max Prince Show, a popular comedy-variety series that is a major hit on the East Coast, but network executive insists that it's too sophisticated for the Midwest, and urges Prince to dumb down his act. Between the tensions of producing an hour of top-quality comedy each week and being pestered about his ratings, Prince is beginning to unravel. His last line of defense against both the network and the ratings are his writing staff, which spends its days coming up with business for the show while hurling humorous invective at each other and anyone else within earshot.

The BCC welcomes Alex Lucchesi, who is making his directorial debut with this production. His cast is a talented mix of BCC veterans and newcomers: Kevin M. Little as Max Prince, Ian Rubinstein as Ira, Ian Kenneally as Lucas, Ricky Bourgeois as Val, Charles McDougal as Brian, Emma Miles as Carol, Madeline Little as Helen, Noah Jung as Kenny, and Brian Dudley as Milt. Susan Lockberg is stage manager.

Laughter on the 23rd Floor opens May 1 at 7:30 p.m. and continues on Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 p.m. and Sundays at 2:30 p.m. through May 18.
