DESCRIPTION: This is a serviceable lower poundage hunting and field bow. American made a quality bow. Very comfortable grip. This one is in good condition except for one significant flaw.

The good: Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No crazing. A few minor scratches, dings, and nicks here and there. Decals are in very good shape.

The bad: There were significant scratches/ gouges in the upper back limb fiberglass of the riser section. These were filled, and the limb re-stained, but up close you can see the flaws (see pics on last page); also one light superficial stress line on the lower back limb in the riser section. This bow is still a shooter, but not a show piece.

This bow cost \$67.00 back in the day (translates to \$348 in 2020 inflation-adjusted dollars), and was considered one of the better deer hunting bows around.
