




Robert Mondavi Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Sourced primarily from the legendary To Kalon Vineyard and other premier sites in Napa Valley.
- **Soil Type**: Well-drained gravelly soils with a mix of volcanic and alluvial compositions.
- **Viticulture Practices**: Sustainable farming practices that emphasize vineyard health and minimal intervention.



Winemaking

- **Harvest**: Grapes are hand-harvested at optimal ripeness.
- **Vinification**: Fermentation in stainless steel tanks followed by 17 months aging in French oak barrels, 25% new.
- Malolactic Fermentation: Complete malolactic fermentation adds depth and smoothness to the wine.

- Appearance: Deep ruby-red.
- Aroma: Blackcurrant, blackberry, and plum with hints of mocha, tobacco, and dried herbs.
- Palate: Full-bodied with ripe dark fruit flavors, complemented by a well-integrated oak structure and polished tannins.
- **Finish**: Long and balanced, with a touch of spice and chocolate.
- **Aging Potential**: 7-10 years.
