TRUSTEES' CORNER

With the passage of changes to the House Rules, Attachment "E" House Rule #30 Queen of Hearts rule number 6, the Trustees, with Aerie approval, have the ability to make changes to the next game. Planned changes will include:

- The sale of tickets up to 3 hours prior to the game drawing on Sunday.
- After the seed money has been replaced (1/2 the ticket money to the jackpot and 1/2 to the gambling fund) the entire ticket sale shall go into the jackpot fund.

It is hoped, with these two changes, that the jackpot amount will grow larger and faster, generating more interest in the drawing and bringing in more revenue for the club.

Please remember that every bar worker, wait staff, special event kitchen workers you see are volunteers, giving up their time to support the Aerie. BE NICE TO THEM. Without them we wouldn't have a club. They deserve your respect and patience! Remember, when you come into the Aerie bar, it is your responsibility and state liquor law to show your card to the bartender. 

Daffodil RV Roamers Club


Did you know that our Aerie has an RV club? We have monthly meetings on the first Tuesday of the month at 7 pm.
