GROWING WHAT YOU MIGHT NOT SEE

³⁵ And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every infirmity. ³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then he said to his

disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; ³⁸ pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." Matthew 9:35-38

Matthew quotes in the 9th chapter of his gospel Jesus' words about the harvest. Many of you know I grew up in a family which grew most of our own vegetables. You also know in 2013-2014 I spent a year in the Midwest. I learned a lot more about farming and about faith. One of the families whom I spent hours with their families, were ranchers and farmers. During this time of the year, I spent time on a combine as the corn was harvested. Farmers practice what we Christians might sometimes call "blind faith" today. The farmer has NO IDEA about the corn until it's harvest time. Sure, we can all see corn stalks growing, and ears forming on the stalks, but we have no idea exactly how good, how filled out, how good the dried kernels will be until they are actually in the wagon.

Our faith is much like these farmers. We sometimes don't know how strong our faith is until we are up close and personal with a plow – or something that might just pull us down.

As we have read through the New Testament, I hope you are experiencing a growth in your faith life that you might not have seen otherwise. I hope you have learned and read passages that you might not have read before. I hope you will continue to be in God's word daily. We are in the harvest season and nature will soon take a time of MENO – resting, abiding, continuing, Continue strengthening your faith – even if you sometimes might not know how your crops of life is producing faithful living.



Thanks to all for their continued support in our Meal Train ministry. It has made a big impact on the families we have served so far.




