Upcoming Tournament – January 10

Our next EPMC tournament is the 2-Man Better Ball, scheduled for Saturday, January 10th. Watch for the Golf Genius signup email, and please sign up early to guarantee your spot, as this event will fill quickly.

We will confirm the roster of players via email on Wednesday, January 7th, and tee times and pairings will be released on Friday, January 9th.

The January event is a **TEAM** tournament, and only one team member needs to register the team in Golf Genius.

How to Sign Up in Golf Genius:

When signups open, please follow these steps:

- 1. You or your playing partner should proceed through the signup confirmation and select "Playing."
- 2. Click "Sign up other members," scroll, and add your partner's name.
- 3. If needed, send a message to the tournament manager with your team pairing and/or any special requests.
- Click "Send". Once you and your partner are confirmed, names appear on the tee sheet roster in Golf Genius. All registered players receive an automated signup confirmation email. As always, we will monitor signups

closely and reach out if there are any issues.

Important Reminders

Please connect with your partner early to confirm availability before registering. If you are signing up as a single, please note this in a message to the manager and we will do our best to pair you with another single.

Tournament size is capped, and a waitlist is used once capacity is reached. If you have any questions or need help with the signup process, don't hesitate to reach out.

Overall, we are noticing a bit of a slowdown in our pace of play. It tends to happen in the winter anyway, but we must be sure we are keeping pace.

Once again, some tips for doing this:

- Do not write your score down when leaving the green; wait until you get on the next tee box
- Keep an eye on everyone's tee shot to help locate it
- When you are behind, putt out and go to the next hole while playing partners finish putting. It's the responsibility of everyone in each group to find ways to keep pace.

If you are in a group that is habitually behind pace, we will take steps that can include moving your tee time back, forcing you to use a cart or possibly asking you to pick up your ball and moving on to the next hole until you are in proper position. We do not want to do any of these options but will do what we can to ensure proper pace during EPMC play.

Zelle Instructions

Hello Fellow Golfers.

Thank you to everyone who has been using Zelle for payments — it greatly simplifies the check-in process. I do have a couple of requests to help keep everything running smoothly:



• Please include your full name and the tournament month in the Zelle payment comment. Example: "Wayne Nichols for November Tournament."

Some payments come through under a spouse's or another person's name, which makes it difficult to identify who the payment is for. Using the tournament month also helps us find your payment quickly.

- All Zelle payments must be submitted by 5:00 PM on the Friday before the tournament. Payments cannot be accepted at the check-in table on tournament day.
- You must still check in at the table even if you paid through Zelle.
 This is the only way for us to confirm your attendance.

Make sure you post all rounds both 9 and 18 holes that you play outside of our skins and monthly tournaments. Also in our skins games make sure to verify your scores by keeping 2 cards in your group and checking hole by hole scores before turning in your card. mistakes as we can. Also please total out your official card so those of us that input the scores can verify the totals with Golf genius.

Merry Christmas to everyone, I hope 2025 was a great golfing year for you. We are excited for what 2026 has in store for El Prado and we definitely will be making sure that we enhance your golfing experience every time you come and play our two golf courses.



We have some great things coming up and want to make sure that we get the word out on these member related activities. The first is that we hired a new Chef and her name is Stella, Chef Stella specializes in Korean cuisine and we have challenged her to revamp our menu to bring our items up to date. We will not be losing our very famous El Prado dogs and Breakfast burritos but will be adding lunch specials that we have never had before. In the next few weeks, we will be adding our ball dispenser at the driving range. Golf Thursday June 4 - <u>Painted Desert</u>, tee times starting at 10:40 AM - Skins game with gross and net skins, closest; and single low gross/net. One or two flights based on size of field.

Golf Friday June 5 - <u>Highland Falls</u> 7:00 AM Shotgun –Skins game with 2-3 flights of gross & net skins, closest; and blind draw partner best ball.

Golf Saturday June 6 - Palm Valley 7:00 AM Shotgun Individual Low Net Tournament paying 30% of field, gross skins, closest.

Saturday June 6 Awards Dinner at the resort. Dinner Buffet from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Dinner starts at 6:30 PM and is included for golfers. Guests are \$60.

Guests are welcome if space is available at the deadline. Guests play to GHIN LI or adjusted as determined by Handicap Committee in prior Getaway performances. If no GHIN handicap, guests will play to 0 handicap. Guests will be in on skins, closest, and Friday two-man blind draw, and Thursday low net/gross; but are NOT in Saturday's ILN tournament. If we have enough guests, there will be a separate tournament pot for guests on Saturday. For golf questions, contact Gary Abbott or Mark Rief
