The SWHNA Board discussed the Des Moines School Board's recent approval of a Drake/DM School partnership to build an estimated \$17,000,000 + soccer stadium East of the Knapp Center on Forest Avenue. Because of many neighborhood calls and comments, the board feels this does involve our neighborhood. Based on several thousand signatures presented, a board motion was unanimously passed by the SWHNA Board to let the Des Moines voters decide if taxpayer money should be used to build this stadium.

What's Happening In The Neighborhood?



- Our "Neighbors Night Out" picnic originally scheduled for August 4th, then moved to October 6th, has been cancelled for 2020....yes, Covid!
- The "Kruse Construction" housing project on SW 56th has over 25 new homes. A nice addition to our neighborhood.
- The old "Valero" store on Park Avenue is vacant and up for sale. Hope a new business comes to the building rescue.
- Fleur Drive construction is ongoing (seems forever) but construction is within the timeline. We are all aware of the traffic back up.
- Derecho? A new word in our vocabulary. Did lots of damage and destroyed many beautiful trees. We all learned to live without electricity. Remember how happy we were when it came back on.
- Jethro's BBQ opened on Park Avenue. A nice, new restaurant. Welcome to the south-side. You join many other great places to eat in our area.
- The walkway, under Fleur Drive, from Waterworks to Gray's Lake is open and looks great.
- We are fortunate to have three large grocery stores and several convenience stores in our neighborhood.

Quick Neighborhood Updates With Emails

Our neighborhood organization will keep you informed on issues involving our neighborhood. The information will be sent via email and your email will never be sold or given to other organizations for any purpose. You will not be burdened with unnecessary and unrelated information. This email system was very helpful in keeping neighbors informed about recent crime situations in our neighborhood. We will also keep you informed about neighborhood meetings, zoning changes and building projects. Over 475 neighbors are already on the list. Email coachdavis@mchsi.com and request to be added. This is **not** affiliated with a National Group called "Nextdoor".

Did Property Tax Increase?

Yes, it probably did. Property tax was based on your home evaluation for 2019. We received our evaluations via mail by April 1st. If property owners disagree with the evaluation, they could have filed a protest from April 2nd to June 5th web.assess.co.polk.ia.us - Protest Forms. The same is true every year. Basically, the protest are "the assessment is not comparable to others with similar properties" or "the property is assessed at more than its actual value". Property owners who disagree with the assessor's estimate of the market value of their property should ask themselves, "Could I sell this property for that amount today?" If the answer is yes, then the value is probably correct. The first half payment for 2019 is due September 30th and the 2nd half is due March 31, 2021.

The City Council does not control the property evaluation or other taxing authorities such as schools, county or state. They only set the mileage rate for Des Moines which was reduced to \$16.61 per thousand. That rate, passed by Council, is the lowest in eight years and is close to the lowest rate in twenty-five years. Our city budget is based on our tax rate.

Will our property tax bill continue to go up? Remember, it is based on property evaluation. Do you see your home losing value? The City Council and Polk County are working to improve every neighborhood.
