

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
JANUARY 14, 2019

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on JANUARY 14, 2019, at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

- MEMBERS ABSENT: None
- ALSO, PRESENT: Town Clerk Shirley Wyles, Town Attorney Ted Ayo, Fire Chief Brock Benoit, Police Chief James Broussard, Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer, and 7 guests.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of DECEMBER 2018." Motion Carried:
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to authorize payment of monthly bills as approved." Motion Carried:
- DISCUSSION: Water Meter construction is going as scheduled with no major complications found per Street Commissioner & Engineers.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to abide by Iberia Parish Ordinance for regulations regarding Recreation Vehicles within incorporated limits of Delcambre". Motion Carried:
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve incentive pay for volunteer fire fighters with the exception of Chief due to a salary being received by the Town." Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve creating Ordinance to reflect future payouts yearly in December". Motion Carried.
- DISCUSSION: Mayor Blakely presented Shawn's Cajun Meats with plaque for year-round support for the Town.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to approve the 2017/2018 Fiscal Year Audit as presented by Matthew Margaglio of Kolder, Slaven and Company." Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderman Donald Martin "moved to approve a variance of 4' as requested by Troy Dubois at 305 W. Judy for a 18' X 74' manufactured home placement. The variance is to be on the front set-back of the Town's right-away with no utilities underground in the designated area." Motion Carried.

- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to approve Police Department Policies and Procedures manual as presented by Assistant Chief Ted Kahn." Motion Carried.
- DISCUSSION: Fire Chief Brock Benoit discussed the issue of new fire fighter needed due to full time fireman, Jacob Hebert, resigning. Ads have been placed in multiple areas, including social media. However, resumes have not been coming in as hoped due to the pay. Chief Benoit is looking into possible part-time staff with no benefits, which will allow for a better hourly pay. Chief Benoit confirms to Council Erath Fire Department is on stand-by for the Town while not staffed.

- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to table Personnel discussion as requested by Homer Stelly." Motion Carried.
- MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to approve 1st quarter conferences as presented by Town Clerk." Motion Carried.
