

Starting Sunday, June 29 at 9:15 am in the church sanctuary. (There will be no Sunday Bible Study on July 13th. Pastor will be gone.)



Chaplain Merlin E. Stephan is our guest speaker on Sunday, July 20 for our 125th celebration.

Chaplain Merlin E. Stephan is a native of Altura, MN. He is an Active-Duty Navy Chaplain assigned to Marine Corps Detachment, Fort Leonard Wood, MO

Chaplain Stephan is a 2007 graduate of Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, MO where he earned his Master of Divinity degree. Ordained on 05 AUG 2007, he served as Pastor at St. Mark Lutheran Church in Rushford, MN from AUG 2007 until FEB 2015 when he reported for Active Duty. Chaplain Stephan is a 2001 graduate of Concordia University, St. Paul, MN and a 1983 graduate of Riverland Community College, Albert Lea, MN. He graduated from Lewiston-Altura High School, Lewiston, MN in 1981. He is Endorsed by the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

Chaplain Stephan enlisted in the US Navy Seabees in OCT 1983. He was Honorably Discharged in APR 1990 as a Construction Mechanic First Class. Chaplain Stephan completed Officer Development School in Newport, RI in MAR 2015 and US Navy Chaplaincy School at Fort Jackson, SC in MAY 2015. He served from JUN 2015 until JUL 2018, completing six patrols in the Indo/Pacific Region with the Okinawa-based 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU).

Chaplain Stephan reported to Combat Logistics Battalion 24 (CLB 24) at Camp Lejeune, NC in AUG 2018. He deployed with the 24^{th} Marine Expeditionary Unit .

He was promoted to Lieutenant Commander on 01 APR 2024. Chaplain Stephan is married to Renee' Karen (ne Schroeder) Stephan. They have no children, and currently live at Fort Leonard Wood, MO.



Bill, Tracy and Pastor continued to meet frequently with FEMA in June. Money from three obligated projects totaling \$175,773.48 has been received. This money was used to pay off current bills.

- ^{ESV} Romans 6:3-4 Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴ We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.
- ^{ESV} **Titus 3:5-6** he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior.
- The Lord's Supper: ^{ESV} Matthew 26:26-28 Now as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, "<u>Take, eat; this is my body</u>." ²⁷ And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, ²⁸ for <u>this is my blood of the covenant</u>, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Creedal and Confessional

- Lutherans (LCMS) bind themselves together through the historic Creeds of the Church: the Apostles', Nicene, and Athanasian Creeds, and the Lutheran Confessions contained in the *Book of Concord of 1580*. Not all Lutherans are "confessional." Why creeds and confessions?
 - <u>They Define the Faith</u>: The Confessions are Biblical- they say what the Bible says by helpfully arranging the Biblical witness into categories, e.g. God, Holy Baptism, the Lord's Supper. When we want to know what the Bible teaches, we can handily go to the Confessions. The Small Catechism is part of the *Book of Concord*.
 - <u>They Regulate the Faith</u>: Because the Confessions are Biblical, they seek to keep the Church saying what Scripture says. In other words, they keep Lutherans aligned with a *pure* scriptural teaching.
 - <u>They Norm the Faith</u>: Because the Confessions are Biblical, they are also are authoritative. They provide a boundary for what our Church teaches and what it does not teach. We don't make it up as we go, nor do we change with the times. The Confessions bind us to Scripture and the Scripture to us.

In our next article, we will discuss how Lutherans also focus on the mission of the Church and how this mission carries the Word of Jesus into our community and to the ends of the earth.

From Pastor's Desk...

125 years by God's grace! Since 1900 we have had <u>thousands</u> of baptisms, confirmations, weddings, and funerals! What drew people to Trinity in the beginning was probably our German heritage and use of the German language, but what kept people was God's Word and being distinctively Lutheran.

What makes Trinity unique today? This question may initially sound a bit proudwhich Lutherans hate. However, you are a member at Trinity <u>for a reason</u> and it's important you understand why Trinity or why The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod.

Word Alone

As Lutherans we are familiar with the terms Grace Alone, Faith Alone, Scripture Alone, Christ Alone. But Scripture is more than a book. We believe that the Bible is what it says it is: God's Word.

- It also does something: ^{ESV} **Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- It delivers faith and Jesus' life, death, and resurrection: ^{ESV} Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. ^{ESV} John 20:31 but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
- God's Word actually delivers and keeps you with Jesus: ^{ESV} John 8:31 So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³² and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Sacramental

- Since God's Word delivers Jesus, we believe that Jesus' life and work come through the Sacraments. Sacraments are those things which have a specific word in Scripture combined with a created thing. Baptism is God's Word and water; The Lord's Supper is Word and bread and wine.
 - ESV Matthew 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
