What is Dismissal? Why do the catechumens, (adults preparing for baptism), leave Mass after the Liturgy of the Word and Homily?

This is an opportunity to provide additional nourishment of the Word of God at a time when they cannot participate in the Eucharist. It also brings to the attention of our Saint Olaf community, that we have catechumens among us that we should "give help to those who are searching for Christ". (RCIA 9).

The prayer for the catechumens describes this beautifully "My dear friends this community now sends you forth to reflect more deeply upon the Word of God which you have shared with us today. Be assured of our loving support and prayers for you. We look forward to the day when you will share fully in the Lord's Table." (RCIA 96)
