Greetings,

We at the Colorado Rockies organization would like to thank our local, state, and federal law enforcement partners for keeping our community a safe place to “live, work, and play.” We recognize the personal sacrifices made for our LEO community each day of the year.

For the 2020 baseball season, we will continue using the “armed” LEO policy that we implemented last season. Our policy mirrors similar policies in use at other sporting facilities in our community. It is our desire to again share this information with the LEO community prior to the commencement of the 2020 baseball season. We wish to make your visit to Coors Field a pleasant experience for you and your families.

If you are “armed” and an active duty, full-time member of a State of Colorado Law Enforcement Agency or a Federal Government Employee assigned to a Federal Law Enforcement entity, we would ask your cooperation in the following manner:

- Please identify yourself to the Guest Services team member as you enter the ballpark.
- Please display your badge and department credential and ask to have your identification confirmed by an Off-Duty Denver Police Officer assigned to the Gate for which you seek entry.
- The Off-Duty Officer will confirm your credentials, review your ticket, and provide your seating information to the Operations Center. They will also request a contact cell phone number from you in the event that Operations Center personnel need to contact you while you are in the ballpark.
- Upon verification of your credentials, a Guest Services team member will place a temporary wrist band on your right wrist. This wrist band is intended to identify you to other law enforcement officers in the event of an emergency. We would ask that you wear the wrist band until such time that you exit the ballpark.

It is our desire that you and your family or companions have a pleasurable experience here at Coors Field. Should you become aware of a disturbance or some other activity that rises to the level of a concern, we would ask that you notify the closest Guest Services team member or text SECURITY to 97474 or call 1-877ROXFANS (769-3267). Your “eyes and ears” can help the On-Duty resources respond quickly to address issues that arise.
