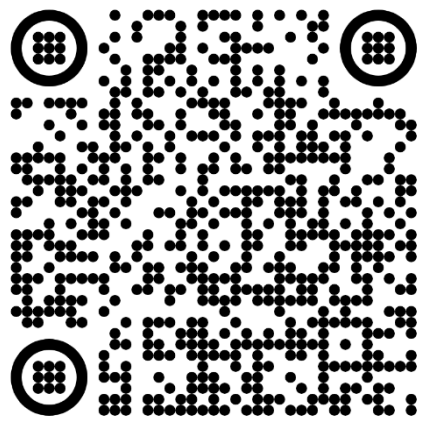


EUMA Rainbow Connection Needs

- Games (board and video)

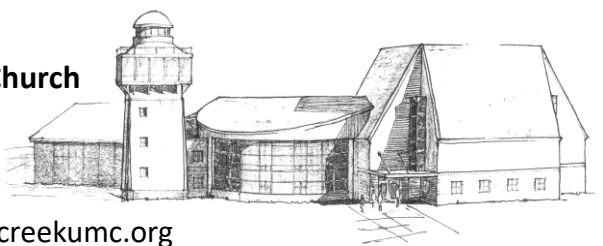
Servant Keeper Online Giving
