WAYS PARENTS CAN CONTRIBUTE

- 1. Provide math or literature enrichment to individual students.
- 2. Assist in compiling, editing, and printing a newspaper of student work.
- 3. Share a hobby or special area of expertise.
- 4. Provide career exploration for students.
- 5. Serve as a coach for Future Problem Solving Team, Odyssey of the Mind, or Junior Great Books Leader.
- 6. Arrange for a guest speaker, a field trip, or a student shadowing experience.
- 7. Research program material for local music performances, share with the students, and transport them to a concert or rehearsal. (Same for a drama, dance, or art experience.)
- 8. Transport students to the library and assist in research and use of the reference room.
- 9. Judge contests such as Science Fairs or Mock Trial competitions.
- 10. Serve as a mentor to a gifted student.
- 11. Make slides, videotapes, and photos of student projects and activities.
- 12. Compile student interest inventory.
- 13. Assist in class projects and independent studies.
- 14. Assist in compiling, typing, collating, and distributing newsletters.
- 15. Watch for special events in the community and share information with staff and students.
- 16. Organize a lending library of professional materials for parents and educators.
- 17. Attend board of education meetings and serve on district committees.
