

Fund-raising For Charities

Each school's PTA, staff and student body would determine and recommend to the Superintendent for approval by the Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-four Board, prior to the reorganization meeting in July, one charity that would be the central focus for any type of fund-raising activity.

As each school would be recommending one charity, this would give three charities for the district. The Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-four Board of Education, where appropriate, may require that a school select an alternate charity. Each school would then have the latitude to fund raise for any one of the three charities.

In addition to the fund-raising activities set forth above, there may be additional fund-raising activities centered on a particular purpose.

For example:

- Food collection for the needy for Thanksgiving holiday
- "Toys for Tots" during holiday periods

The schools shall not participate in non-designated fund-raising for charity except upon written authorization of the Board of Education. Such authorization may be sought by submitting a proposal to the Superintendent of Schools.

The Superintendent of Schools must approve all fund-raising projects in advance. All requests for fund-raising projects shall be submitted on the appropriate form (#5139.1a) to the Superintendent of Schools. These proposals shall include all pertinent information such as purpose(s), sponsor(s), supervisor(s), dates(s), and times(s).

In addition, a description of the actual fund-raising activity will be included in the proposal.

The Superintendent will furnish, in writing, his/her decision concerning the proposed event.
