## Food Pantry Updates

The Little Closet Community Food Pantry provided food for 318 individuals in the Samantha and surrounding communities during the second quarter of 2016. Those numbers represent 93 children and 225 adults – 121 total families.

The Food Pantry is open to the public for distribution on the 4th Tuesday of each month from 4:00 p.m. til 6:00 p.m. We serve Northwest Tuscaloosa County and Southeast Favette County, with a primary focus on the Samantha Community. A photo ID and proof of residence such as power bill, phone bill, etc. are required to receive services.


