The following rules and guidelines will be enforced. Please take note of the USA Archery Dress Code that will be enforced. It is listed on the next page.

By signing up for the tournament your agreed to the following:

NFAA Waiver

Dress Code

- 1. Must present a professional, athletic appearance (torn, ripped, or heavily soiled clothing articles are not allowed).
- 2. 2. Shorts, skorts, and skirts must be professional in appearance and length.
- 3. Camouflage clothing is only disallowed for broadcast/live streamed medal matches at national events and after the first cut at U.S. Team Trials Events.
- 4. 4. Denim is allowed, but must not be torn, ripped or have holes (see Appendix A for examples).
- 5. 5. Leggings (tight fitting/yoga-type stretch pants) are allowed but must not be transparent/translucent above the knee.
- 6. 6. Upper garments must cover the front and back of the body, and the midriff when at full draw. They must also have sleeves.
- 7. 7. Shoes must cover the entire foot unless pre-approved by USAA due to an injury or disability. Sport/athletic shoes are recommended.
- 8. 8. At no time will any article that bears wording, insignias, innuendo or images determined to be offensive or inappropriate be allowed. All hate symbols and hate speech on clothing, personal effects and your person is strictly prohibited, whether worn on the person or not. The National Events Manager and/or Event Organizer is responsible for the enforcement of this policy in conjunction with the Chair of Judges (COJ) or their designee.

Tournament Format

Saturday

- ⇒ 5 Arrow ends of 3 Minutes and 30 seconds
- \Rightarrow 12 ends total
- ⇒ Check <u>BetweenEnds</u> for your lane assignments
- \Rightarrow Electronic timer in use
- ⇒ Electronic and paper scoring
- \Rightarrow AB/CD target format
- ⇒ Bottom ALWAYS shoots first
- ⇒ Archers flip after 6 ends, bottom to top, top to bottom.

Sunday

- \Rightarrow Each Match is 4 ends
- ⇒ 5 Arrow ends of 3 Minutes and 30 seconds
- ⇒ Recurve Set Scoring 2
 points for winning end, 1
 point for tie, zero points
 for losing end.
- ⇒ Most points after 4 ends wins match
- $\Rightarrow \ \mbox{4-4 tie is a 1 arrow shoot} \\ \ \mbox{off, closest to center wins} \\$
- \Rightarrow Most wins in flight wins.

Seating

Seating is available for archers. The archers seating area is for ARCHER'S ONLY. No exceptions except for those requiring pre approved assistance. Please be courteous to the archers so they can perform at their highest level.

As this is an NFAA tournament, spectator and coaching seating is anything behind the archers. You can go up to your archer and briefly give them food/water etc. Please return to the spectator area immediately after completing your task.


Arrow Requirements

Maximum arrow shaft diameter allowed in NFAA competition will be 0.422 inches, with point diameter not to exceed 0.425 inches. The shaft diameter will include any wrap placed on the arrow and will include the size of the nock and the nock insert. If the arrow wrap, nock, or nock adapter exceed 0.422 inches in diameter and are embedded in the scoring area of the target, the arrow shall not be scored and will be reshot.

Between Ends Scoring and Wifi

- \Rightarrow Archers will be using paper and tablet scoring
- ⇒ Scoring will be live via this <u>BetweenEnds.com</u>
- ⇒ We will not be giving out the new password to ensure the tablets work smoothly on the system.
- ⇒ We have installed a Cell Phone signal booster to help with your cell signal.

The July Juggernaut is a unique tournament. Please familiarize yourself with all the rules. I will be going over everything verbally prior to the start of competition. Fell free to ask questions.

Please make sure you hydrate yourself during the tournament. Even though we are indoors, this bldg. gets very warm. Water is free as usual.

Make sure your equipment is ready for the tournament. Check all the nuts and bolts, arrows, string, etc. Make sure you have the appropriate number of arrows in their quiver. Hint, it is more than 3. Make sure y our arrows are USA Archery legal.

MOST IMPORTANT:

Public service announcement. You are 100% responsible for the accuracy of your scorecard. It does not matter if you were writing or inputting the scores on the tablet, calling arrows or assisting. You are responsible for it being correct. This is a State Championship, make sure your scores are accurate.


How do I get there?

The Ben Avery entrance you need is NOT the one at the stop light. The entrance you need is the one closest to I-17. It is on the North side of the road about 1/8 mile west of I-17. There is a big sign.

From I-17, Heading west from I-17 take the first right onto the Ben Avery Shooting Facility Property and follow the road as it curves left. After the road is heading west, take the first right and another immediate right. You will see the bldg. on the right. Beige metal building.

From Lake Pleasant Parkway, Heading east form Lake Pleasant Parkway, go straight through the traffic light. You will come to the main entrance on your left. Nice brick sign. Enter. Go straight until the road itself curves left. After the road is heading west, take the first right and another immediate right. You will see the bldg. on the right. Beige metal building.

Be prepared for a lot of road closures this weekend. ADOT, MCDOT and the City of Phoenix are all doing road repair and expansions over the weekend. See <u>AZ511</u> for current road conditions the Friday
