
About 19 Corvettes met at Guru's for lunch and then afterwards drove over to Don Ipson's car collection nearby Dixie Downs Road.

This event was billed as an overnighter option. Many stayed over in the Provo area while others made the late-night drive back to St. George. You will drool over these pictures.




