

Eligibility and How to Apply

Katie Blair House (KBH)

Katie Blair House is a HUD, DOH and DMHAS funded program for homeless women who are:

- Not able to be diverted or slated for PSH AND
- At least one prior episode of homelessness (except for young adults) AND
- In one of the following life stage transitions
 - young adults 18-24,
 - interested in recovery
 - fleeing DV and DV cause of recent homeless episode

Eligibility:

Women who are at least 18 years old

Ideally 30 days sober/clean

Documentation proving homeless status using the Balance of State Homeless Verification Form located at <http://www.csh.org/csh-in-the-field/connecticut/2578-2/>

Ideally scoring between 4 to 7 on the VI-SPDAT

We cannot accept applicants with charges of child molestation, arson or assault

Process for referring a client:

Send the completed Coordinated Access packet to KBH@BethsaidaCT.org

Patricia's Place Program (PPP)

Eligibility:

Women who are at least 18 years old

Homeless, at risk of homelessness, or low-income

30 days sober/clean

Proof of ability to pay \$125 per week and \$250 security deposit required

(revised 11/2/2017)

If DMHAS funded, participants will begin paying the program participation fee (\$125 per week or daily pro-rated amount) plus a \$250 security deposit on the first day they are no longer eligible for DMHAS funding (housing funding for Bethsaida)

Preference is given to Katie Blair House graduates

We cannot accept applicants with charges of child molestation, arson or assault

Process for referring a client:

If a client is homeless, send the completed Coordinated Access packet to PPP@BethsaidaCT.org

If the client is not homeless, email PPP@BethsaidaCT.org

Flora O'Neil Program (FON)

Eligibility:

At least 18 years old

Documentation proving homeless status using the Balance of State Homeless Verification Form and proof of disability using the CT BOS CoC – Disability Documentation Form located at <http://www.csh.org/csh-in-the-field/connecticut/2578-2/>

Ideally scoring 10 or greater on the VI-SPDAT

Must be able to have electricity turned on and listed in applicant's name

We cannot accept applicants with charges of child molestation, arson or assault

Process for referring a client:

The New London County Coordinated Access packet (that was approved on 3/30/2015 and should be filled out by the CAN intake worker) must be sent to the Universal Screening Committee. The Universal Screening Committee then prioritizes those individuals/families.
