First Lesson 2 Chronicles 7:12-16 [12](#) Then the Lord appeared to Solomon in the night and said to him: "I have heard your prayer and have chosen this place for myself as a house of sacrifice.[13](#) When I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain, or command the locust to devour the land, or send pestilence among my people,[14](#) if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.[15](#) Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place.[16](#) For now I have chosen and consecrated this house that my name may be there forever. My eyes and my heart will be there for all time.

Second Lesson 1 Corinthians 2:10b-16 For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.[11](#) For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.[12](#) Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.[13](#) And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.[14](#) The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.[15](#) The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one.[16](#) "For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

Gospel Matthew 22:34-40 [34](#) But when the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together.[35](#) And one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him.[36](#) "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"[37](#) And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.[38](#) This is the great and first commandment.[39](#) And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.[40](#) On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets. "
