## **BOX OF JOY**

Cross Catholic Outreach's *Box of Joy* is the current service project for the SLC DCCW. A Box of Joy is a Christmas shoebox that is donated and packed with toys, clothing, supplies and other treasured items. Each child who receives a Box of Joy also receives a rosary and a booklet titled *The Story of Jesus*. Box of Joy provides hope to children in need; each gift represents Christ's love and may be the only Christmas gift they receive.

A flyer was E-Mailed to all affiliates asking for support of this service project in July (asking for a response by August 6). I heard from St. Vincent de Paul (36), St. James Vernal (25), St. Anthony's (50), St. Peter's (5) and St. Marguerites (20). Boxes can be dropped **by appointment only** on October 25<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> & November 2<sup>nd</sup>. November 1<sup>st</sup> hours will be 11am-3pm. As in the past you will be asked to donate \$9.00 for each box. The procedure is different this year. **Do not include your \$9.00 in the box itself**— donations can be done 3 ways:
