A local law requiring prior written notice of any defective condition before commencement of civil action ~~against~~ against the Village of Cohocton

Article 1.-This local law shall be known and cited as the Prior Notice of Defect Law.

Article 2.-No civil action shall be maintained against the Village of Cohocton for damages or injuries to person or property sustained in consequence of any street, highway, bridge, culvert, vault, stairway, sidewalk, or crosswalk being defective, out of repair, unsafe, dangerous or obstructed or for damages or injuries to person or property sustained solely in consequence of the existence of snow or ice upon any sidewalk, crosswalk, street, highway, bridge, culvert, or stairway unless written notice of the defective, unsafe, dangerous or obstructed condition or the existence of the snow or ice, relating to the particular place, was actually given to the Village Clerk and there was a failure or neglect within a reasonable time after the receipt of such notice to repair or remove the defect, danger or obstruction complained of or to cause the snow or ice to be removed, or the place otherwise made reasonably safe.

Article 3.-The Notice required herein shall be in writing, dated and signed by an individual having personal knowledge of such defective condition and said notice shall set forth the basis of said personal knowledge. Said notice shall further set forth and describe said defective condition, the exact location of the same and when said defective condition was first discovered or observed.

Article 4.-The notice required herein shall be served upon the Village Clerk or, in the absence of the Village Clerk, on the acting Village Clerk or Mayor by personal service or by registered or certified with return receipt mailing.

Article 5.-The Village Clerk shall cause to be kept an index of notices of defective conditions wherein said notices shall be preserved.

Article 6.-This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
