



"How are you, GI Joe?"

"Trinh Thi Ngo, who has died aged 85, was, for a generation of American troops serving in Indochina, better known as 'Hanoi Hannah', the silken-voiced propagandist on North Vietnamese radio, the Voice of Vietnam, who tried to convince GIs, in impeccable English, that they should lay down their arms and go home "

"She claimed not to have felt any hatred towards the American people and later life expressed the hope that she might one day visit the land of her former enemies: 'San Francisco has always been a dream. And the Golden Gate Bridge and Hollywood, I'd love to see them, too.' Obituary UK Telegraph 16 OCTORER 2016
