1907-1990

Frank A. Taschner, 82 of Sebewaing, passed away unexpectedly Tuesday, Oct. 30, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City.

Mr. Taschner was born Nov. 7, 1907, in Sebewaing, the son of Charles and Catherine (Stoeckle) Taschner. He was married to Sally E. Jones in Sebewaing on Dec. 21, 1940.

He was employed by Sebewaing Brewing Company for 26 years and then by Burroughs Elevator Co. for six years. He had built several homes in the Sebewaing Area. He operated Frank's Sharp Shop for 40 years and was caretaker of St. John Lutheran Cemetery for 26 years. He was a member of Holy Family Church and Sebewaing Sportsmen's Club.

Surviving are his wife, Sally, four sons and daughters-in-law; four daughters and sons-in-law, including Nancy and Elmer Schuette of Pigeon; 21 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. He also leaves three sisters, one brother and several nieces and nephews.

Three brothers, one sister and two grandsons preceded Mr. Taschner in death.
