## 1919 - 1998

Elsie E. Lehman, age 78 of Caseville, passed away Thursday, February 19 at Bay Medical Center in Bay City following a long illness.

She was born in Huron County on December 10, 1919, the daughter of the late William and Matilda (Schmidt) Stach. She was united in marriage to William R. Lehman at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Bach on August 24, 1946. He preceded her in death on May 10, 1976.
