2013 ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERSHIP June 8, 2013 **MINUTES**

She heard that the gate was to remain shut but it is the only way her furniture can be moved out due to the size of the moving truck she needs to move on that day. She also promised to monitor the gate while the move takes place so that we don't have people passing through the neighborhood. With that said Linda made a motion to weld the gate shut on the 5th of July and allow Lenora the use of the gate on the 1st of July, Robin seconded the motion, all in favor, no opposed, motion carried.

The Board then went on the give the owners an update of the work they are putting in progress. Roofing and Asphalt work will hopefully be done before the end of this year and we plan on painting and doing wood repair work on a building or two a year.

The Association now has assets of over \$200,000.00 and we have no delinquent owners for the first time in a very long time. Betsy Vincent thanked the Board for all their hard work. They have done a great job in the past two years.

The election results were then announced by Glenda. Jerry, Robin and Linda were re-elected to serve a two year term and the IRS Ruling was unanimously approved.
