- Purchasing Multi-media equipment for the Visitor Center Auditorium
- Purchasing Laptop & DVD player for the amphitheater
- Funding for printing Junior Ranger booklets and other educational materials plus the track rubbing booklets; Wapiti Nature Trail Guide, Adventure Cub booklets and certificates
- Funding for bear resistant dumpsters for the campgrounds
- Funding for benches on hiking trails and bike racks
- Assisted with Visitor Center repairs
- Published *Guide To Historic Sites* and *Mueller State Park Edible and Medicinal Plants* booklets
- Published Trail Guide, "Miles To Hike"
- Purchased Penny Smasher machine for the Visitor Center providing souvenirs to collectors and delighting children
