General Show Info

Entries: Entries will be accepted for sixty-five riders. Others will be waitlisted. Secretary will notify you once your entry has been accepted.

Schooling Day: July 19th: Schooling is available at \$30.00 per horse and open from 2-6pm.

Show Day: July 20th: Rings will open at 7:30am. No riding will be available in the show rings in the morning. Hand walking is available 30 min prior to show time. Schooling on day of the show is available at \$50.00 per horse if you have not entered two or more classes.

No classes can be added the day of the show.

RPHSA Membership: An \$8.00 Non-Member Fee will apply to all those not signed up for RPHSA.

Stabling Options:

Saturday day/overnight (<u>NO</u> schooling) and Sunday day: \$85.00. **IF** you are schooling on Saturday add \$30.00 (Total \$115.00)

Sunday ONLY stall: \$60.00

Shavings \$9.00/bag

Horses can arrive after 2:00pm on July 19th and no later than 6pm.

No refunds after closing date.

Awards: Show themed Ribbons first through sixth place.

Six high percentage awards: Intro Jr & Adult, Training Jr & Adult, Upper level Jr & Adult.
