Outdoor Playtime

As well, if you wish your child to wear sunscreen, please apply it before coming to preschool. Thanks!



R E M I N D E R

- If your child is not feeling well, or appears tired, or a bit "off", please do not bring them to Preschool. As well, if your child requires medication (even Tylenol) within 24 hours prior to the start of the child's class time, they may not attend class that day. Thank you for doing your part to help keep sickness out of our school.
- If your child has travelled outside of Canada, the Preschool requires the child not attend class for a period of 1 week from date of arrival home.
- The Preschool continues to adhere to the illness policy (any child with cold/flu symptoms, must stay home until symptoms have resolved and/or child is not reliant on medications.)
- The health and well-being of our students is our top priority, and being that our student population is unvaccinated, we are being proactive in our approach to limit the possibility of Covid variants spreading through our classrooms

LEARNING THROUGH PLAY

With warmer weather rapidly approaching, our classes will often be taking their learning outside to the playground. Did you know that physically active play, like climbing, swinging, and running can help children to:

- Develop large muscles, strength, and balance
- Develop flexibility and coordination, including hand-eye coordination
- Develop skills such as throwing, catching, hopping, skipping, climbing and balancing
- Develop awareness of space, such as over/under, in front/behind, on top/beneath, inside/outside
 - Develop mathematical concepts such as long/short, big/small, wide/narrow
- Be confident in controlling their bodies and learn their limits
 - Learn to cooperate and share
- Understand that physical activity is fun and can release tension
