

Raymond L. Foy

1920 - 1996

Raymond Lebert Foy, age 75 of Caseville, passed away Tuesday, August 20 at his home following a long illness.

He was born in L'Anse on August 25, 1920, the son of the late Julius and Ada (Giroux) Foy. On June 29, 1946 he was united in marriage to Helen M. Steudle in Warren. She survives him.

Mr. Foy worked as a caulker in the bricklaying industry, retiring from Statewide Caulking in January, 1982. In November, 1987, he and his wife, Helen, moved to Caseville.

He was a World War II Army Tech Sergeant, having served part of his time in Germany as a prisoner of war. He was a Charter Member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Village-Stinson Post #9021 in Warren, a member of the Caseville Fraternal Order of Eagles #3690, and a B.A.C. Union member for more than 40 years. Mr. Foy was also a member of the Cross Lutheran Church in Pigeon.

Surviving him are his wife, Helen; two daughters, Patricia (Thomas) Tesh, Caseville and Tracey (Raymond) Cutway, Shelby Township; two sons, Jeffrey (Judy) Foy, Warren and William (Laurie) Foy, Macomb Township; eight grandchildren: Lynn (David) Strausborger, Gregory, Brian, and Rebecca Foy, Suzanne and Nicholas Cutway, and Lauren and Alexa Foy; a sister, Margaret (Lester) Jones, Radcliff, Kentucky; a brother, Clifford (Florence) Foy, L'Anse; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by two sisters, Sylvia Boyer and Lila Antoine, and a brother, Frederick.

Funeral Services will be conducted at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 24 from Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon. Rev. Raymond E. Orth, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Caseville Township Cemetery.
