Frank Thomas "Tom" Jablonski, age 68 of Pigeon (formerly of Warren) passed away Sunday, July 20 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe.

He was born in Detroit on March 20, 1929, the son of the late Frank and Ruby (Eckersley) Jablonski. On April 15, 1950 he was united in marriage to Jean Dueweke at the St. Clements rectory in Center Line. She survives him.
