Mr. Yale States the setbacks are not an issue, however he came across some language in the land use ordinance that may relate to this review and is unsure if it would apply where the use involves warehousing/storage. Page 24, Section 2, item D: "Multi-family, Residential, Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Development" explains loading facilities must be located entirely as the same lot as the building is to be served.

Mr. Adelman In reviewing this section finds this would not apply as the language goes to further refer to expansion of the building. This building is not being expanded or enlarged.

Mr. Sullivan Asks if there are any other questions form the board, there are none. He makes a motion to accept the application and approve it.

Mr. Adelman Seconds the motion
