Dear all,

I hope you have all had a good week and enjoyed the netball this weekend.

Unfortunately a lot of last week was taken up with trying to sort out communications and rules from the Surrey Junior Netball League - communications which were really quite grim to read, and actually, in some cases, really quite difficult for us to action. I will endeavour to explain why these rather draconian rules are necessary.

The League is run over 6 venues. After the last fixtures on 15th September, 3 out of these 6 venues threatened to kick the league out as clubs weren't sticking to the venue rules. These are not idle threats. A couple of seasons ago the league lost Epsom College overnight, because parents had parked their cars incorrectly. All the rules are coming directly from the venues. Unfortunately unlike other sports, England Netball do not own any sites, and all clubs and leagues are at the mercy of local schools for their venues.

All the "venue" rules were sent out before the first fixture, and unfortunately they were nearly all broken by various clubs, so the league had to send out another note to try and grab attention. It is a very sad state of affairs but if we lose our venues the girls do not get matches. It is as simple as that.

The league is all run by volunteers and they are doing their best to ensure that girls still get netball, by policing the playgrounds, making sure no one arrives early, no one parks badly etc. Sadly there were more parking issues yesterday at Manor House, and we are all currently hoping that this is not going to cause an issue, as the league were on a last warning.

I do find the strictness of the rules quite embarrassing and really not good for our sport especially as we just want parents to come out and enjoy themselves, but unfortunately clubs are not reading the messages, and hence the messages from the league are getting louder and more shouty just to protect the use of our venues.

From a club point of view, we just want the girls to play netball, so we will support the league in any way we can to ensure that the matches can continue.
