We'll meet for lunch immediately after the parade at John & Sandra's house (211 East Wise Street, Trenton, SC) and enjoy

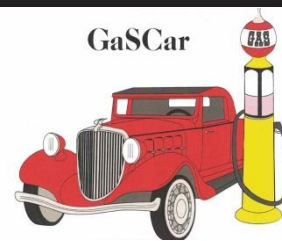
