Charles S. Wolfenden, age 73 of Caseville, passed away Friday morning, May 10 at his home after a long illness.

He was born March 16, 1918 in Detroit, son of the late James and Louise (Slegwart) Wolfenden. He was united in marriage to Marjorie Schanehorn on Aug. 5, 1939 in Detroit.
