April sees the end of Lent, the days are longer Sunset an hour later and where the showers helps the flowers, for Spring.

The first week is Holy Week.

The 1<sup>st</sup> : Last Saturday of Lent. Violet Vestments

The 2<sup>nd</sup>: Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. Commemoration of the Lord's Entrance. With Palms and Procession. Red Vestments.

The 3<sup>rd</sup>: Monday of Holy Week. Last Monday of Lent. Violet Vestments. Confession during day as posted.

The 4<sup>th</sup>: Tuesday of Holy Week. Last Tuesday of Lent.

The 5<sup>th</sup>: Wednesday of Holy Week. Last Wednesday of Lent. Last day of Violet.

The 6<sup>th</sup>: Thursday of Holy Week. The beginning of Sacred Paschal Triduum. Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper. Transfer of the Most Blessed Sacrament procession. Chrism Mass at the Cathedral in the morning is when the Sacred Oils are Blessed. No other Masses. There is Morning Prayer.

The 7<sup>th</sup>: Friday of the Passion of the Lord. GOOD Friday. Celebration of the Lord's Passion at 3PM. Adoration of the Holy Cross, and Holy Communion. Paschal Fast continues until Easter Vigil. Veils removed from Crosses following services.

The 8<sup>th</sup>. Holy Saturday. Only Penance, Anointing and Holy Communion as Viaticum. Veils removed from images before Easter Vigil.

The 9<sup>th</sup> Easter Vigil traditionally at Midnight Sunday. Beginning the Octave of Easter. One continuous 8 days of Easter. Masses for Easter Sunday Morning continue the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord.

The 10<sup>th</sup>– 16<sup>th</sup> Easter Octave to Divine Mercy Sunday. And 50 days of Easter Season.
