Attendance:

- 16 regular members, 0 guests present.

Opening – Ken Normandy:

- Ken called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Introduction of Officers

Secretary's Report – Steve Thurmond

- June minutes read and approved with one change that work hours are to be reported to the club president or person acting in that capacity.

Membership Report –Steve Close:

- No new members,
 - 0 – First readings, 0 second reading
- Currently we have 71 general members and 8 seniors for a total of 79.
- 1 Senior member resigned
- Collected \$660 in dues over the last 2 month.
- 12 dues reminders were sent out.
- No work credits were applied.

Treasurer's Report – Bill Means:

- Club paid out \$850 for rental property clean up to "Demetrio Garcia Inc." due to lack of volunteers.
- Tenant left mid-July and property is currently vacant, see rental property for details.
- Club is currently paying ~\$60/month in utilities instead of collecting rent.
- We are positive cash flow at this time (no heating yet)
- Counting all our cash assets, we have \$31,693 as of Sept 9th, 2023.

Rifle Team – Steve Thurmond:

- Rifle league practices on Thursday evening, and will resume officially in the fall.
- J. O. Qualifier Match will be held at Southport on Saturday January 13th - 14th 2024.
- Sectional match to be held at Southport on Saturday March 2nd -3rd, 2024.
- Top shot match proposed for Sunday Oct. 22nd the day after the pistol Octoberfest match. Jon Speck will post details that are yet to be determined.

Pistol League – Bill Means:

- The .22 pistol leagues started week of September 11th.
- Oktoberfest match to be held on Saturday 21st
 - 2 relays 09:00 AM and 1:00 PM.
 - Needs range helper and range officers

Maintenance – (Jim Conti or is it Vacant?):

- Glass block window, on north side pending.
- Looking for maintenance folks for the league season
 - Shaun Walrath volunteered.
- Still need volunteers to paint the bathroom floor.
- Arlie Tucker made new wood bench for bathroom.

Rental Property – Tony Del Frate:

- Tony not able to attend (dental appointment) but communicated to board members.
- Club paid \$850 to have rental exterior maintenance done due to lack of volunteers for July 15 work party.
- Mail box moved to east of access road from in front of the house, as ordered by Post Office.
 - Send important mail to the club's PO box not mail box for security reasons.
- Renter moved out mid-July without giving proper notice, left considerable garbage in the house, carpets soiled, and a foul odor in house.
 - Tenant did not give any reason for leaving, will ask Tony to follow up to see if she had any complaints.
 - Security deposit is being kept.
 - Tony has put in considerable time and resources to clean the rental to get it ready to rent in October. Work is still being done
 - Security deposit may need to go to Tony to cover his expenses.
- Monthly rental cost to be raised to market average of \$1050/month, which should help to attract good renters.

New Business:

- New website coming, because the outdated format of existing site.
 - Need to update e-mail list for member to be able to log onto site
 - New site is secure
- Talked about ideas to help ensure club gets volunteers to do maintenance instead of paying to have services done.
 - Secretary (Steve Thurmond) volunteered to call or talk to members directly to get a commitment for future work parties.
- Discussion that club may need to raise dues if club has to pay for maintenance.

- Ed Delgadillo will not be participating in pistol league or helping with matches this fall due to his wife's health issues. Please keep them both in your thoughts and prayers.
